Kyocera Corporation and Century Tokyo Leasing Corporation announced last year that Kyocera TCL Solar LLC, a joint venture established by the two companies, has completed construction of two floating mega-solar power plants. The plants will generate an estimated 3,300 MWh per year in total – enough electricity to power approximately 920 typical households.
